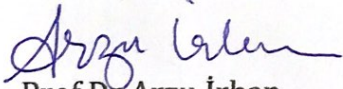
I am an anesthesiologist and a pain physician. I am Prof at Health Science University, Istanbul, Turkey.

My main interest is pain management. During my daily practice hypertension and hypotension are the most frequently seen symptoms during interventional treatments. Most of the time hypertension is related to the fear of needle, intervention, or unknown; hypotension is related to being hungry, vagal syncope, neuronal blockade vs.

I am using Shvabe Abp approximately for 6 months in my daily practice in hospital. I have seen that in both cases of acute hypotension and hypertension, it is very effective to achieve normotension and its effect is very fast. Although it works 6 min., the aim is achieved at 2nd or 3rd min. I may say that this tool is effective and its effect is rapid,
